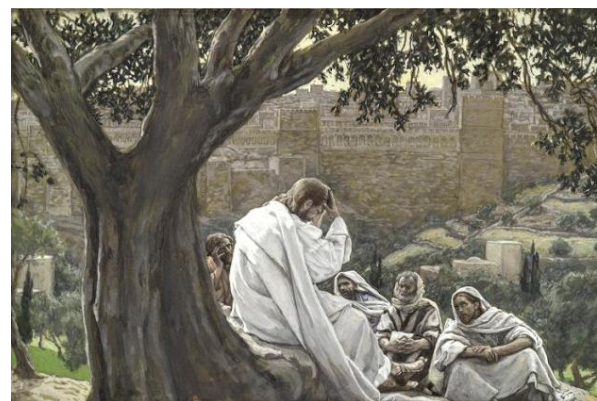

CLERGY ONLINE ASSEMBLY: Last Wednesday we held a clergy assembly with all the priests of the diocese. Various topics have been discussed regarding end of financial year statements. We also discussed a possibility of carrying out building surveys throughout the Diocese. Chartered surveyors would visit all the buildings. Cost of our 2 Parishes would be estimated at around £12,000.00 This is definitely something that has to be considered and if it is wise to spend that amount of money for surveys.

PLASTERING AND REPAIRS TO ST. MARY'S: Over the years I have tried many different jobs in the Parishes trying to fix this and that – plastering will certainly be my first. Many thanks to Paul May, who offered up his time to replaster the 'weeping wall' at St Marys Chapel House. It is certainly taking a bit longer than expected. From the attached photos, you see how much has been done. Good news is that the wall appears to be dry where the watermarks were but the amount of debris behind was definitely contributing to the water stains when passing



condensation. We have also found what we believe to be late Canon Gilles' slipper – I bet he looked for it everywhere! The last time St Marys underwent major refurbishment when the walls would be stripped was during his tenure. He was a great role model for me to follow. Next week, Duncan MacDonald will begin decorating. Many thanks for help with moving of the furniture and to John MacKay for the roof work and help with the leaks. There is still a leak to be traced in the en-suite bathroom. Weather and time permitting, John will try to locate it and fix. John will also replace a broken glass panel in the Church, which Paul brought from Glasgow. Iain MacQueen fixed some doorknobs in the house. Many thanks for all the help!
