


VISITORS: Welcome to all our Visitors!

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: I understand that few years back there used to be a separate service for the Stations of the Cross. However, due to poor attendance and parishioner's preference, we continue with this important Lenten Devotions by incorporating them at Mass on Tuesdays (24.02; 10.03; 24.03) Wednesdays (04.03; 18.03) and Fridays (27.02; 06.03; 13.03; 20.03; 27.03). Please, make an effort to attend on these days.
