FOOD BANK NEEDS OUR HELP: Please, continue with your generosity!

SAFEGUARDING: As you know, the National Safeguarding Conference took place in Edinburgh on 5 October this year. Six Safeguarding representatives from our Diocese, including Margaret Andow from our Parish were able to attend. We appreciate how difficult it can be for most people from this diocese to travel such a distance. However, we do feel it is important to include everyone involved in safeguarding and to keep you up to date with national safeguarding issues. Therefore, Liz Chaplin, one of our Diocesan Trainers, has kindly shared some of the key points from what was a very full and interesting day.

•There was some very interesting input on Survivor Trauma and Secondary Trauma (including its impact on listeners) including the Amygdala Hijack response and how trauma can hugely affect a

person's ability to recall or tell about their abuse. "8 Keys to Safe Trauma Recovery" by Babette Rothschild was recommended reading.

•There was an update from members of the Independent Review Group, who are very keen to keep on top of things and were generally very supportive of what Tina and everyone else are doing.

•There was also a fascinating lecture on Spiritual Abuse by Dr Lisa Oakley whose area of research is spiritual abuse in Christian communities. She linked it with coercive control (as within marriages) and described it as emotional/psychological abuse in a religious setting - due to an imbalance of power. Her book - "Escaping the Maze of Spiritual Abuse" by Lisa Oakley and Justin Humphreys, June 2019 was recommended reading.

EDUCATION SUNDAY: This Sunday is Education Sunday, marking the start of a week when we celebrate the importance of educating children and young people in faith.
