R) God of hosts, bring us back; let your face shine on us and we shall be saved.

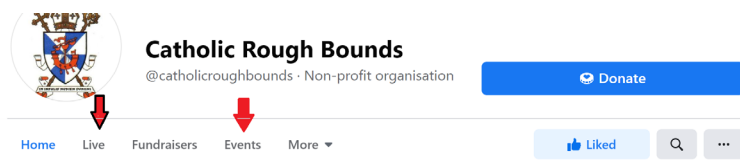

HOW TO ACCESS ONLINE MASS: This Pandemic has forced many of us to learn more and more about computer and internet usage. A lot of forms, bookings etc. are done over the internet without any paper. If you would like to benefit from our online presence, watch Masses, have instant news from the Parish and the area, you can go to:

In the menu bar, when you click 'Live', it will take you to our livestreaming Masses. If you click on 'Events', it will help you to Book your places. You can also access 'Videos' where you will find all Services.

If you do not have a Computer or Tablet, consider asking your family member to buy it and set up for you. It is very simple to use and will allow you to join in with others.

NOVEMBER: On Sunday, at the back of the Church, you will find envelopes for the November Dead List. Put in the envelope the list with names of your deceased parents, relatives, all for whom you wish to pray. Return as soon as possible to the Chapel House (by post or in person through the letter box) or the Church on Saturday/Sunday. Names will be added on and read out during Sunday Masses in November like every year. Include your offering in the envelope. We will remember in particular this year those who died due to the pandemic.

APPEAL FOR HELP: I am grateful for all your financial support. Fundraising has been done entirely on Parish level and we continue to pay our monthly levies, which have been increased now to **100%** of pre-covid state. Despite our Masses being available to the Public, our income has actually fallen even further. **At the moment, the Parishes are running a deficit, which means there is more money coming out as going in.** Morar is sending £718 to the Diocese every month. Arisaig £459. This situation is a real financial struggle on the Parish. Thank you so much for your support!

CLERGY SALARIES: “The bishops decided last week not to increase the clergy stipend for 2021. Also all salaries at BCOS and diocesan offices will be frozen at present level pending a review in 6 months. It was felt that given present financial difficulties in the country, the Church should show solidarity with all those suffering financially.” As it currently stands, the Salary of a Parish Priest is £256.50 per month. It does not depend on how many Parishes, Churches or the area he has to cover. It will remain like this for the whole of 2021.

THANK YOU: Sometimes, I receive an anonymous donation. Normally, I try to properly thank for all the donations but in such instances, I do not hold a return address. I want such people of Good Will to know that their support is very much appreciated! I thank the Lord for your generosity and kindness.

RESUMPTION OF PUBLIC MASSES: We are allowing people to participate at Daily Mass. Booking is required for Saturday-Vigil in Morar and Sunday Mass in Arisaig. Please go to events section of our Parish Facebook to book your free ticket. You can also call the Chapel House, but you should use the online facility first. There is a limited number of people allowed. **St. Patrick's, Mallaig; St. Donnan's, Eigg; St. Columba's, Canna; remain closed to the public.** Weekday Masses will resume on 30th October.

Booking is not required for Weekday Mass, however maximum capacity limit still applies. You have to leave your name and phone number on the list as you walk in for Weekday Mass. THIS RULE DOES NOT APPLY TO SATURDAY-VIGIL and SUNDAY MASS WHERE BOOKING IS STILL REQUIRED IN ADVANCE.

Please note that until the COVID-19 threat is over, Sunday Mass attendance is not obligatory. I would like to assure you that we are doing all we can to make our spaces safe to the public following the guidelines. I am sure that in time we will be accustomed to the new regulations.
