Last week we welcomed the Papal Nuncio, Archbishop Claudio Gugerotti, to our diocese. We are delighted that in his first visit to Scotland the Pope's representative came to Argyll and the Isles as we celebrate the Feast of St Columba, 1,500 years after his birth.

On the anniversary of the dedication of our Cathedral, the



bishops of Scotland gathered together for the first time since the start of the pandemic. The young people from St Columba's Primary and Oban High Schools read beautifully in Gaelic and English. The congregation delighted in being able to sing again.

A wonderful day despite our original travel arrangements being cancelled due to the weather. A quick change of plans allowed the Papal Nuncio and the Scottish bishops to travel to Iona on St Columba's Feast Day, joined by local parishioners. After receiving hospitality in the Catholic House of Prayer we celebrated Mass in the Abbey's Church. As we were celebrating 1500 years since the birth of our patron this was particularly special. Afterwards the Iona Community kindly gave us lunch in their newly refurbished Refectory.

CONGRATULATIONS: The awards of Lilian and Angus will take place in Arisaig on the 22nd June. There will be no refreshments after Mass for Parishioners due to other arrangements made. Thank you to all, who already volunteered to help. I appreciate your kindness.

FIRST COMMUNIONS/CONFESSIONS: We will Celebrate First Communions on 27th June at 12 noon in Morar. First Confessions will take place today, 13th June. We pray for our Children.

VISITORS: Seasonal pressures are certainly upon us. Nevertheless, we must not forget the happiness we bring to all the visitors who enjoy the beauty of our area. There always has to be a balance.

PARKING: I know that this is a touchy subject for some, but I would like to ask you to leave the parking spaces in Arisaig in front of the house available to our Guests. There has been some feedback about being blocked access to the house by Church goers. There are plenty of other parking areas available so please use them instead. I would also like to ask you to leave access to the garage in Morar available at all times. We blame the tourists for blocking our driveways and taking up parking spaces but are we really that different from them?

MAJOR REPAIRS AT ST. MARY'S: At the noticeboard you can find a proposed repair work which will take place next Spring/Summer. We were able to secure some funding from a Donor to carry out an extensive roof work repair. That extent of repair work (and expense!) has not been done to St. Mary's for a long time. There will be some disruptions for the duration of the repair, but I hope that once the exterior is fixed, we will be able to progress to internal problems like painting the walls inside.

PARISH 100 CLUB
