Catholic Church in Scotland - Request to Abuse Survivors

During April 2022 the Social Care Institute for Excellence (SCIE) will be conducting an independent review of Safeguarding in the Diocese of Argyll and the Isles. They want to hear from people with first-hand experience of how the Diocese has responded, or failed to respond, to reports of abuse or the sharing of concerns. No-one in the Church will be told you are taking part - it will be completely confidential, and you will not be identified. ST. MARY'S RENOVATIONS: Works are to begin on 19th April (Tuesday) with the erection of the scaffolding. Last Sunday Mass at St. Mary's is going to be celebrated on 24th April. There will be no weekday services after Easter Sunday. Beginning in May Masses are going to be celebrated:

- 30th April / 1st May: Saturday-Vigil in Morar at 6pm; Sunday Mass in Morar at 10am; Sunday Mass in Mallaig at 12noon
- 7th / 8th May: Saturday-Vigil in Morar at 6pm; Sunday Mass in Morar at 10am; Sunday Mass in Mallaig at 12noon
- 14th / 15th May: (No Saturday-Vigil); Sunday Mass in Morar at 10am; Sunday Mass in Mallaig at 12noon
- 21st / 22nd May: (No Saturday-Vigil); Sunday Mass in Morar at 10am; Sunday Mass in Mallaig at 12noon
- 28th / 29th May: Saturday-Vigil in Morar at 6pm; Sunday Mass in Morar at 10am; Sunday Mass in Mallaig at 12noon
- In June we should be returning to normal schedule.
