WE PRAY FOR THE SICK: There are a lot of people not well at the moment and require our constant prayers and support. There are so many people that occupy my thoughts and prayers at the moment. Please. Do not lose your faith in prayer! It works miracles. I am always ready to administer the Sacrament of the Sick whenever you ask. It is not an imposition; I am happy to carry out this ministry. I will always respect your privacy and confidentiality.

Almighty and Eternal God, You are the everlasting health of those who believe in You. Hear us for Your sick servants for whom we implore the aid of Your tender mercy, that being restored to bodily health, they may give thanks to You in Your Church. Through Christ our Lord.

SPECIAL COLLECTIONS: Today, 11th/12th June, Day for Life (do not use GA Envelopes). Next Special Collection 18th/19th June for Presentation for Deacon Bua on the occasion of his ordination (do not use GA Envelopes).

BISHOP'S VISIT: Bishop McGee will be visiting the Parishes in Morar and Arisaig on the weekend of 11th/12th June. Bishop will make some visits to the Housebound. We are grateful that Bishop McGee was able to find time to see us in his busy schedule. Bishop McGee will also make a visit to the Isles during the summer, beginning with Isle of Eigg on the 7th July and Isle of Canna in August.

CORPUS CRISTI: Next Weekend we will be celebrating the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. I would like to take this opportunity to re-introduce the possibility to receive the Blood of Christ once again. However, as we are still being careful, you will only be able to receive via Intinction. Intinction is the Eucharistic practice of partly dipping the consecrated bread (BODY OF CHRIST), into the consecrated wine (BLOOD OF CHRIST) before consumption by the communicant. I would like our Eucharistic Ministers to hold the Chalices once again and allow Parishioners to dip their Body of Christ into the Chalice. We have to be careful with this practice and approach Communion with utmost reverence for the Blessed Sacrament.

ONLINE CLERGY ASSEMBLY: Will take place on Tuesday, 14th June between 1pm-3pm.

CAMPING WITH GOD: Once again, after Covid break, we will be welcoming Polish Catholics from the Prayer Group from Scotland. Some will be staying on campsites; others will make use of the Chapel House in Arisaig. Since they have no priest staying with them like before, I have agreed to provide pastoral care and support. Additional Masses will be celebrated on Saturday, 18th June and Monday, 20th June.

COPIER: Parish Copier has been serviced last week. It is now 6yo but at the moment, all seems to be in perfect order with it. I trust you are enjoying the way Newsletters are being produced.

THANK YOU TO VOLUNTEERS: I would like to thank all our volunteers who look after the Churches and Parish grounds in Arisaig, Morar, Mallaig, Eigg and Canna.

CHANGES IN THE DIOCESE:

- Fr Roddy Johnston, presently Parish Priest of Ballachulish, Taynuilt and Mingarry will move to St Andrew's, Rothesay as Parish Priest.
- Fr Noel Nkop msp will become Parish Priest of the Visitation, Taynuilt while also remaining at St Margaret's, Lochgilphead.
- St Mun's, Ballachulish and Our Lady of the Angels, Mingarry will be served by the Missionaries of St Paul. Fr Pius Duke, who joined us for the Chrism Mass, is no longer able to take up this appointment but his replacement will arrive in July.
- Rev Philip Bua will be Assistant Priest at Our Lady and St Mun's, Dunoon.

The appointments for Rothesay, Taynuilt, Ballachulish and Mingarry will commence on Friday 24th June. Rev Philip will cover Ballachulish during July and move to Dunoon in early September after his holiday.

Bishop McGee thanked Fr Roddy and Fr Noel for what they have given to their respective parishes and for generously accepting these changes. He also thanked Rev Philip and the MSPs for their willingness to serve God in their new parishes.

MORAR/MALLAIG SOCIAL COMMITTEE MEETING: I would like to invite you for a meeting on 15th June (Wednesday) at 7pm to Chapel House in Morar.

ARISAIG AMERICANA: From what I witnessed during last weekend's concert and heard from other attendees; it was another success for the festival. We congratulate Mungo and Mairi and other volunteers!

MORAR COMMUNITY COUNCIL: After the last AGM, I will continue as Chair for another term. It is a great privilege to participate and work with other Community Councillors. It also makes me feel as being part of this community. Thank you.

MORAR POWER CONNECTION: This will take place within the next 7months. A 3-phase supply is going to be provided to the House/Church in Morar. Works come with significant cost going above £10000. We were able to secure a contract without any payment required from the Parish. This will secure the connection to Morar for years to come and allow further improvements in the future as decarbonisation takes place. Mallaig already has a 3-phase connection from the previous heating system provided. Arisaig at the moment has separate supply in the Church, Club Room and the Church which is sufficient to our demand. Many thanks to Chris Rice, Alistair Neil MacKay for all the improvements to guarantee safety and reliability of our electricity supply.
