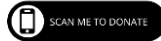

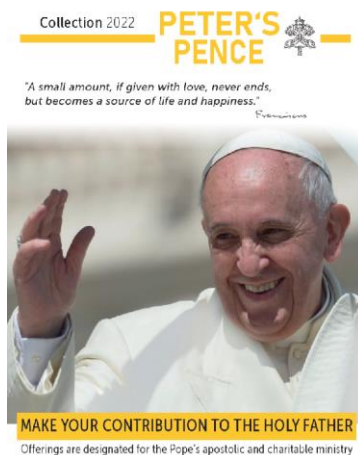

SAFEGUARDING UPDATE FROM THE DIOCESE:

Thank you for taking the time to return the Training Deadline Survey Report which Katie sent to PSCs and Parish Priests in May. The results from that showed that the vast majority of you (92%) agreed that the Diocese should set a deadline for those who have been unable to meet the 18 month deadline for attending Part 2 training. The majority of people thought that a one month deadline was too short with most of you saying 3 or 6 months was about right. Almost everyone thought that a combination of face to face and online training was the best way for delivery of training in our Diocese.



The results of the survey were discussed at the DSAG (Diocesan Safeguarding Advisory Group) meeting earlier this month. It was decided that 30th November, St Andrew's Day, would be a good deadline date. This is more or less 3 months after the summer holidays.

Bishop Brian and all the other members of DSAG asked me to tell you how much the Diocese appreciates the work you all do and how much you are valued. It is stating the obvious that the Diocese could not meet the Safeguarding Standards of the Catholic Church in Scotland without every one of you.

We are aware that there has been very little voluntary work going on in parishes during the pandemic and that some volunteers may have forgotten the importance of safeguarding. I know that some of you have restarted some activities and others are in the planning process. One suggestion we had was that before you restart groups, you might meet with your volunteers for a short refresher meeting. You could discuss how the group/activity is going to restart and give them their Role Descriptors and Standard of Conduct leaflets if you haven't had a chance to do so yet. You could also refer to the relevant Safeguarding Risk Assessment and generally remind them of the importance of the work they do. On behalf of Bishop Brian and DSAG, I would ask you to let all your volunteers know how much the Diocese needs and values its volunteers. They have a very important role in sharing the work of the church.

SOUP AND SANDWICHES IN MALLAIG, 31ST JULY: We were able to book the hall in Mallaig and are now looking for volunteers to help with preparing soup, sandwiches and baking and also to help on the day. We have some wonderful bakers in our area and if you can prepare something, it would be greatly appreciated. There is a list at the back of the Church.
