**POPE FRANCIS:** We pray for Pope Francis as he is recovering in hospital from an infection. Last message on VaticanNews (Thursday, 30.03) was that his condition is improving.

**LED BY THE SPIRIT MEETINGS:** Anne was kind enough to organise 2 meetings for the Parishes. Arisaig Parish will meet after Sunday Mass in Arisaig on the 16<sup>th</sup> April. Morar and Mallaig will meet after Sunday Mass in Mallaig on the 23<sup>rd</sup> April. I was told that some people misplaced the forms for consultation. I have printed them off again and leave them at the back of the churches.

**ARISAIG PHONE NUMBER:** Soon, our current contract runs out. For the past few years, calls from 450223 were diverted to Morar, but since having a phone line might become more expensive due to the transition into digital phone lines, we might only keep broadband on for the guests. This means that soon, the line will not be active.

**SOUP AND SANDWICHES:** I have asked Ann Martin to save us a date in July for our Parish Fundraising event in Arisaig. Details will be available closer to the date. I am sure that like before, it will be a great gathering and day for the Arisaig Parish.

**MALLAIG CHURCH ECO GRANT:** I am considering applying for an Eco Congregation Grant for Mallaig Church (up to £80,000) to install new energy/heating solutions. This might mean some structural changes to the outside of the church, to potentially install solar panels etc. Before I apply for any funding, I am open to hearing your suggestions to these potential changes to the Church Building. Any upgrades intend to minimise the running costs and increase energy efficiency.

**CHRISM MASS:** It was good to see other priests in Oban last week. We have a fresh supply of Oil.

**EASTER CHOIR PRACTISE:** Our singers are invited to Morar on the **4<sup>th</sup> April at 7pm**. Many thanks to Alison Young for her assistance with the organ. I am so grateful for her help whenever required. Lilian MacDonald will be leading the practise. Thank you to all our dedicated singers for enriching the Liturgies.

**EASTER CONFESSIONS:** I will be available in Morar on the 5<sup>th</sup> April at 5pm after a short penitential service. You can also arrange a suitable time individually. Fr Cromby will also make himself available after Easter. In accordance with the precepts of the Church you must go to confession and receive communion at least once a year, preferably around Holy Week/Eastertide. This is commonly referred to as one's Easter duty.

**ADULT BAPTISM:** I will be delighted to welcome Kate MacLennan into the Church. Kate will receive her Baptism, Confirmation and First Communion during our Easter Vigil Liturgy in Morar. I ask you for your prayers for Kate and her family. It requires a lot of courage to make a decision to become a Catholic as an adult. It is indeed a great privilege for a priest to perform a Baptism during Easter Liturgy. Simon will receive his confirmation.

**GA ENVELOPES:** At the back of the Churches, you will find your new Gift Aid Envelopes. Please remember that after 5<sup>th</sup> April 2023, you will have to discard all the old envelopes (number beginning with 22). Thank you so much for your generosity. Gift aid is extremely important source of Parish income.

**FR STAN'S EASTER BREAK:** I will be away between 11<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> April. Fr William Cromby has kindly agreed to provide cover in my absence and will be staying in Morar between 15<sup>th</sup> – 23<sup>rd</sup> April. I have left a list at the back of the Church to help make him feel welcome. Fr Cromby will be arriving either by train or by bus so will require lifts. I have asked Fr David in Fort William for help in my absence when Fr Cromby is not here. He can be reached at 01397702174.
