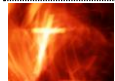

DAY FOR LIFE 2023: The Bishops decided at their meeting that the Day for Life will be celebrated on the 3rd Sunday of June, beginning next month. This ties in with the celebration in both Ireland and England/Wales. Although it is celebrated that particular Sunday, the collection need not take place that same day if it is not convenient. The Bishops ask you to encourage the Day for Life and also the income since the grant making fund is now very low since the pandemic.

DONALD MACVARISH RIP: Funeral Service will take place in Morar on the 1st June at 6.30pm.

ARISAIG PHONE NUMBER: Soon, our current contract runs out. For the past few years, calls from 450223 were diverted to Morar, but since having a phone line might become more expensive due to the transition into digital phone lines, we might only keep broadband on for the guests. This means that soon, the line will not be active.

An approximate postcode is AB37 9JS. Coaches need to stop half a mile beyond Chapelton. Cars and minibuses can park very near and are usually willing to take anyone needing a lift.

JOURNEYING WITH MARY – Prayer Service in Preparation for the Synod: Carfin Grotto - Feast of the Visitation Wednesday 31st May 2023 7pm. At the invitation of Pope Francis the Bishops' Conference of Scotland is hosting an hour of prayer at the National Marian Shrine, Carfin, for the success of the Synod. All are most welcome. Personal reflections will be shared on four aspects of Mary's life interspersed with silence, hymns and the Rosary while pilgrims journey between various Marian stations. Tea etc will be available at 8pm. The Prayer Service will be livestreamed on beingCatholic.com . On the Feast of the Visitation Pope

Francis has also encouraged prayer at diocesan and parish level for the success of the Synod. The National Liturgy Commission will share some materials.

Scottish Faith Leaders Declaration on Fair Pay in the Social Care Sector: We believe in the importance of human dignity. We honour those people who serve, care for and support others so that this dignity can be respected and that all may have fullness of life. We thank them for their time, hard work and compassion.

We believe in fairness and justice, and believe that all staff working in social care in Scotland today should be paid fairly for this fundamentally important work. We recognise the challenges today facing social care staff and providers, following the difficult years of the Covid-19 pandemic, the cost of living crisis and the current challenges with recruitment.

We call on church and faith communities to encourage and support advocacy and fundraising for better social care in Scotland. We recognise recent commitment made to the Adult Care Workforce but call on the Scottish Government to do everything within its power to ensure all frontline social care workers be paid a minimum of £12 per hour immediately, and that the appropriate funding is made available which allows all social care staff to be recognised for their skills, experience and contributions, in whichever role they serve.
