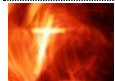

SOUP AND SANDWICHES: I have asked Ann Martin to save us a date in July for our Parish Fundraising event in Arisaig. Details will be available closer to the date. I am sure that like before, it will be a great gathering and day for the Arisaig Parish. The date 20th July, 2023.

AIRBNB: I am pleased to inform you that both Kilmory and Chapel House in Arisaig are fully booked for the whole of summer. I would just like to ask you to respect the parking arrangements so that our guests would have access to the properties at all time. Thank you for your understanding. It will be an extremely busy period for me, making sure that all is working out for our guests.

GRASS CUTTING: Thank you to all the volunteers who are helping with cutting grass and maintaining the garden.

SCALAN: The Annual Pilgrimage to Scalan takes place on Sunday 2nd July with Mass outdoors at The Scalan beginning promptly at 4.00pm. Scalan can be found a mile beyond Chapeltown of Glenlivet. An approximate postcode is AB37 9JS. Coaches need to stop half a mile beyond Chapeltown. Cars and minibuses can park very near and are usually willing to take anyone needing a lift.

MORAR PARISH COUNCIL MEETING: Thank you for your participation. We had a good meeting in the Chapel House and enjoyed a cuppa!

1. Here is the response for the Bishop:

-Parish recognises the need for extra burial plots for the area and unanimously agreed to allow this to happen. We are pleased that the Catholic Church can assist the wider Community

-Parish has consulted with the current lease holder of the Croft and received his support to proceed with the sale of land belonging to the Parish

-Douglas MacKellaig has been delegated to assist and represent the Parish in any matters that might arise. Douglas has my complete support and I am sure he will protect Parish interests. Fr

Stan would like to limit his involvement in the matter to absolute necessity. We understand that decision lies ultimately with you and the Trustees of the Diocese

-As part of the sale, we would like to make stipulation on 2 key points:

oUpkeep of boundary fence of the graveyard would be a responsibility of the Highland Council
oConsidering that part of the land (part marked in blue on the plan) would be where the existing access gate to the Croft is located, we would like the Council to facilitate new entrance to allow the use of the Croft in the future.

2. We are planning Soup and Sandwiches in Mallaig sometime in August and Bingo Night later during the year. Lindsay will coordinate these events.

3. Fr Stan is grateful for all the fundraising efforts in the Parish. Parish is no longer running the deficit which means that the income allows us to pay all the bills. Fr Stan applied for a Grant for our annual insurance bill and will continue his efforts.

4. We are looking into re-painting St. Patrick's. (Fr Stan would like to erect a wee board at the back to encourage online donations from visitors.)

5. It was accepted that we should offer some support to poorer Parishes and send some relief to Mingarry. They have been fundraising to repair their heating system.
