**ARISAIG SUMMER FINANCE UPDATE:** I am pleased to inform you that the costs related to repairs of Kilmory after last tenancy ended have been met by the Diocese. Of course, there was some cost related to upgrades to enable letting and fulfilling License Requirements, but the income so far has covered these as well. I can only express my gratitude to the Bishop and the Diocese for assisting with this. This would be worth to remember when we carry out Diocesan Special Collections over the summer.

I am hoping to replace another 2 arched windows at the top floor of the Chapel House after the season, but this should also be facilitated from the income over the summer, even though they would carry significant expense to be like-for-like replacement. Last week, a pipe/tap burst, and Jamie Young was prompt to assist, even though it happened just before midnight. Thank you to all the local tradesman who so far have come to my rescue in need. Hughie and Anne have been kind enough to help assemble and organise garden tables for our guests. John and Alistair Neil MacKay have come to my rescue as well when needed.
