OCTOBER DEVOTIONS: Please remember about the Rosary in the month of October. There is a plenary indulgence for recitation of the Rosary in the Church, the family or pious association. Five decades of the Rosary must be prayed continuously. The prayers of the Rosary must be prayed vocally, and one must meditate upon the Mysteries of the Rosary. If the recitation of the Rosary is public, the Mysteries of the Rosary must be announced. Plenary indulgence can be gained only once a day. Three other conditions must be fulfilled: a Sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, Prayers for the Pope's intentions. In addition, one must be free of all attachments to sin, even venial sin. If this complete integrity is not present or if the above conditions are not fulfilled the indulgence is only partial. Both a plenary and partial indulgence may be applied to the dead.

OLD ARISAIG GRAVEYARD APPEAL: Works have begun on the Graveyard. If you would like to make a contribution toward the project, I would like to invite you to do so. I hope to finalise the works, involving, cutting trees, disposing of old materials and tidying the area. Works will be carried by a licensed workers and I hope will be finalised by November – month of Holy Souls. Bishop McGee will say a Prayer over the Dead during his next visit. Please, share this information among friends and relations who might also wish to contribute toward the project. There are donation envelopes available at the back of Arisaig Church. I am extremely grateful to Lilian MacDonald, Anne MacDonald, Donald MacEachen with his son in law Thomas, Hugh MacDonald and Iain MacQueen for their help. It would be impossible without their help to load the skip before picking up. Thank you.

BISHOP MCGEE / EIGG AND CANNA: We remember about our Bishop as he will be attending the Synod in Rome, representing the whole Church in Scotland. He was unable to visit Canna so Fr Jarek will visit the island (weather permitting) on 4th October. He will go to Eigg on Thursday.

OCTOBER MASS INTENTIONS/ANNIVERSARIES: Beginning 29th September, I will be away on my annual leave, visiting my parents in Poland and taking some time off by myself. Fr Jaroslaw Kwiecien will be providing cover, arriving with his cat to Kilmory on 27th September now due to some diary complications in the Cathedral House. Fr Jarek is the latest priest joining our diocese and has kindly agreed to provide this vital supply. In my absence, he will celebrate daily masses (without streaming) as per our usual rota. He will be using my car, so make sure you do not confuse him with me in case he gets caught speeding! If you would like Fr Jarek to celebrate Masses in your intentions, you can ask him in person, and he would announce on the day. I am sure we will provide him with a warm welcome and I am planning to return around 20th October.

DEVOTIONS: We will continue with the Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Litany to the Sacred Heart every Friday after morning Mass.

NOVEMBER: Envelopes for the November Dead List are available at the back. Please, put in your envelope the list with names of your deceased parents, relatives, all for whom you wish to pray. Return as soon as possible to the Chapel House (by post or in person through the letter box, preferably when I am back from my break) or the Church on Saturday/Sunday. Names will be added on and read out during Sunday Masses in November like every year. Include your offering in the envelope. We will also be celebrating Vespers for the Dead on first three Sundays of November at 5pm (5th in Arisaig; 12th in Morar; 19th in Mallaig). Please, I encourage you to attend this Special Liturgy of the Church.

ADVENT RETREAT: I know we are still a long way from Advent, but I wanted to inform you that beginning this year, we will be holding Parish Retreats in preparation for Christmas. This is part of our Spiritual Renewal efforts in the Parish, to follow the guidance from Led by the Spirit. I was able to invite Fr Bernard Fox, a Mill Hill Father and Sister Sally Hyland to lead us in prayer. Our Retreat will take 3 days 12-14 December and will be filled with Spiritual Talks and Guidance for Parishioners. Our Retreat will have one of the most renowned preachers in Britain among Christian Communities! Mark the dates 😊

LAUDATE DEUM: will be Pope Francis' next Apostolic Exhortation on the Climate. It will be published on 4th October and available on Vatican Website. It will certainly make a good read for me during the flight.

PAINTING OF THE CHURCH: We are aiming for end of November/beginning of December to have the Church painted in Arisaig. It would be lovely to have it ready for Christmas. During the works, Church will remain temporarily closed with Sunday Masses celebrated in Morar instead. I will give exact details closer to the date.
