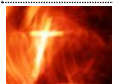

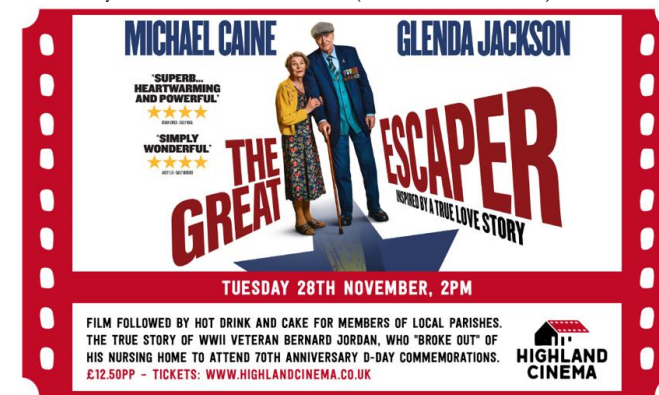

We will also be celebrating Vespers for the Dead on first three Sundays of November at 5pm (5th in Arisaig; 12th in Morar; 19th in Mallaig). Please, I encourage you to attend this Special Liturgy of the Church.

REMEMBRANCE SERVICE: This year, I will lay a wreath at the Arisaig War Memorial on Sunday, 12th November at 9.30am, coordinated by Rev Goudie this year. Please, join us if you can in the act of Prayer for those who offered their lives in service to us.

ADVENT RETREAT: I know we are still a long way from Advent, but I wanted to inform you that Spiritual Renewal efforts in the Parish, to follow the guidance from Led by the Spirit. I was able to invite Fr Bernard Fox, a Mill Hill Father and Sister Sally Hyland to lead us in prayer. Our Retreat will take 3 days 12-14 December and will be filled with Spiritual Talks and Guidance for Parishioners.
