celebrating Vespers for the Dead on first three Sundays of November at 5pm (5<sup>th</sup> in Arisaig; 12<sup>th</sup> in Morar; 19<sup>th</sup> in Mallaig). Please, I encourage you to attend this Special Liturgy of the Church.
