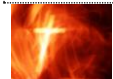

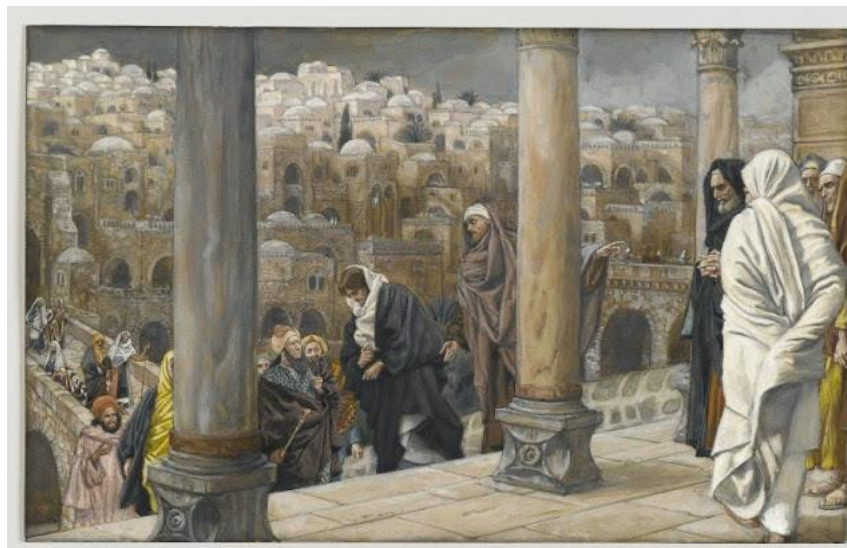

VG: Fr Roddy has stepped down from his role as Vicar General. Bishop McGee is incredibly grateful to Roddy for his support and friendship over the past 8 years as he exercised this Office. Bishop knows that he was extremely approachable for both clergy and laity. Bishop thanked Fr Roddy for embracing his responsibilities so seriously and for having served us all so diligently and pastorally. He has appointed Fr Michael Hutson as Vicar General. He is grateful to Fr Michael for accepting the increased responsibilities and knows that we will all support Fr Michael in this important role. He is also grateful to Fr Michael for having exercised so faithfully the role of Chancellor for the past 8 years.

I am afraid that Fr Roddy has been diagnosed with cancer. It was his wish to receive end of life care in Mingarry. At the moment he is in the Belford Hospital. I went to see him on Thursday and he looked really poor.

CHANCELLOR: Bishop has appointed Fr Ronald Campbell as Chancellor. We know that Ronald has many qualities and varied experiences which will stand him in good stead. He is grateful to Fr Ronald for accepting his request to serve the diocese as Chancellor.

CLERGY ASSEMBLY: On Wednesday 20th March we will celebrate the Mass of Chrism in the Cathedral at 6.30pm. Our Clergy Assembly will begin with lunch at 1pm in the Bishop's house. At 2.30pm Bishop John Keenan will lead a reflection on the priesthood and the support of priests today, including ongoing formation. This is very as priests will renew their

commitment to the priesthood during the Chrism Mass. Bishop John recently attended a conference in the Vatican entitled 'Rekindle the Gift of God that is Within You'. About 1,000 priests and bishops from 60 countries attended the Conference which consisted of prayer, talks, reflection and Conversations in the Spirit. Supporting our clergy has been discussed during the last number of Gatherings, and rightly so, because it must be a priority. The Assembly will give us an opportunity to reflect on the priesthood at home but also learn about the priesthood in the rest of the world. Bishop John will be Bishop Lead for clergy support in Scotland and he is very interested in listening to priests.

NEW BISHOPS: Bishop Frank Dougan has been appointed as the new Bishop of Galloway. I am glad I was able to attend his Ordination Mass. Fr Martin Chambers has been appointed as the new bishop of Dunkeld. His Ordination Mass will be celebrated in the coming weeks. This means that again we have a full contingent of Bishops in Scotland. We keep our Bishops and Clergy in prayers.

HOLIDAY: After a week back, it seems that my holidays were ages ago. This will be quite an intense time of preparation for Easter. I had a good rest and brought best wishes from Fr Pawel in Austria. I am sure he will have an opportunity to visit us this summer.

ANGELA MACLELLAN RIP: Sad news about Angela. Her Requiem Mass will be celebrated in Morar on the 26th March at 12 noon with Cremation to follow in Inverness on the following day. We offer our prayers for Angela and her family.
