**DAY FOR LIFE:** Today the Catholic Church in Great Britain and Ireland marks our annual Day for Life, established by Pope Saint John Paul II to recognise the value of human life at every stage and condition, and to draw attention to the seriousness of abortion and euthanasia and other aspects of human life deserving our consideration. In recent years our Day for Life Collection has helped fund our traditional pro-life organisations as well as supporting survivors of sexual abuse and those with addictions and caring for refugees and asylum seekers. This year's theme, *The Lord is My Shepherd*, focuses on Compassion and Hope at the End of life against current efforts to legalise assisted euthanasia. **APPEAL:** The Bishops of major English speaking countries have decided to update the liturgical texts (obligatory), beginning in Advent 2024. I would like to appeal to our friends and parishioners, if perhaps someone would like to sponsor the books. If we pre-order before the end of June, we can do so with a discount. It is an extremely high cost for rural parishes in particular and I am grateful for your help. All donated books will have a special inscription and considering the last ones were about 50 years old, it will hopefully be a long-term purchase – unless the Bishops decide otherwise. Parishes will require:

1. St Mary's, Arisaig - £695 for 4 volumes (PLEDGED FROM MERAC MACDONALD)
2. St Cumin's, Morar - £695 for 4 volumes (DONATED IN MEMORY OF MARIE MACLEOD RIP)
3. St Patrick's, Mallaig - £695 for 4 volumes; 4. St Columba's, Canna - £395 for 4 volumes;
5. St Donnan's, Eigg - £395 for 4 volumes.

If you would like to donate the books for use in the Churches, they will be marked with an inscription from the donor. I am grateful for your assistance with these and realise it is a significant amount. If you would like to, you could ask other parishioners to share the cost of the set. We still need donors for 3 sets.
