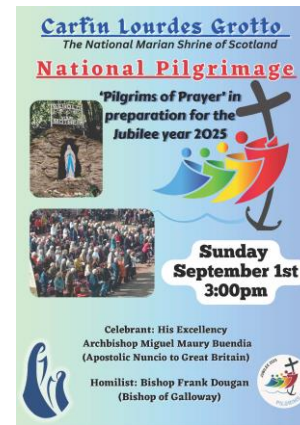


GRASS IN MORAR AND MALLAIG: My thanks to Duncan and Michael for their help with grass cutting in Morar and Donald, Hughie and Anne in Arisaig. With the grass season full on, I am doing what I can to help out in Morar with the grass but if we have a volunteer who would like to be part of the Rota on regular basis, it will assist me a lot. I usually do it once a week. Please speak to me if you can volunteer – Iain and Szymon have joined our team in Morar. We are looking for some help in Arisaig. Despite our efforts, we are unable to find a gardener to help with the grounds. We have approached someone new from Arisaig but that has proven unreliable so far. I am really counting on your help. With the income from the house, of course we

would pay for this labour but to keep an audit trail, we require a bill – this is sometimes a difficulty in encouragement of new workers.

HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION: The Solemnity of the Assumption is a Holy Day of Obligation. There will be a vigil-mass in Mallaig on Wednesday, 14 Aug at 5pm in Mallaig and Mass on Thursday, 15 Aug at 10am in Arisaig.

NEWS FROM THE DIOCESE: The Missionaries of St Paul are sending Fr Charles Egbon to our diocese as a replacement for Fr Walter. Bishop McGee has spoken to Charles by telephone, and he is excited to be among us. He is presently in a parish in London. Fr Charles will minister in St John's, Caol and St Mary and St Finnan, Glenfinnan. He arrives on September 4th.



Clergy Assembly: The Clergy Assembly is a very important event for all our clergy, priests and deacons. When so many of us live at a distance from our nearest brethren it is good to spend several days together. The Assembly is from Tuesday 10th- Thursday 12th September.
