### FRIDAY – All the Faithful Departed

All Saints' Day is a solemnity in the Catholic Church celebrated annually on November 1. The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all those who have attained heaven.

Although millions, or even billions of people may already be saints, All Saints' Day observances tend to focus on known saints --that is those recognized in the canon of the saints by the Catholic Church.

Generally, All Saints' Day is a Catholic Holy Day of Obligation, meaning all Catholics are required to attend Mass on that day, unless they have a valid excuse, such as serious illness.

### SATURDAY – All the Faithful Departed

All Souls' Day, which is observed on November 2, and is dedicated to those who have died and not yet reached heaven. The day is primarily celebrated in the Catholic Church, but it is also celebrated in the Eastern Orthodox Church and a few other denominations of Christianity. The Anglican church is the largest protestant church to celebrate the holy day.

Return as soon as possible to the Chapel House (by post or in person through the letter box, preferably when I am back from my break) or the Church on Saturday/Sunday. Names will be added on and read out during Sunday Masses in November like every year. Include your offering in the envelope. We will also be celebrating Vespers for the Dead on first three Sundays of November at 5pm (3rd in Arisaig; 10th in Morar; 17th in Mallaig). Please, I encourage you to attend this Special Liturgy of the Church.

**REMEMBRANCE SERVICE:** This year, I will lay a wreath at the Arisaig War Memorial on Sunday, 10th November at 9.30am. Please, join us if you can in the act of Prayer for those who offered their lives in service to us.

**ADVENT RETREAT:** I know we are still a long way from Advent, but I wanted to inform you that Spiritual Renewal efforts in the Parish, to follow the guidance from Led by the Spirit. I was able to invite Fr John Eagers to lead us in prayer this year. Our Retreat will take 3 days 9<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> December and will be filled with Spiritual Talks and Guidance for Parishioners.
