GRANT FOR MORAR PARISH: I am extremely proud to inform you that Morar

Parish has received an award of short of £28,000 to convert an unused Boiler Room into Disabled Toilet for Parishioners. It was a long process, but the Panel was impressed with our application. Please note that this is a Restricted Grant which means that it is not intended for anything else but to cover the construction costs. We will use local contractors so that these funds will also remain in our local community as much as possible. It does not mean that 'the Priest' or 'the Parish' is 'loaded', as I recently heard. The only reason we are able to apply for funding is because we are able to meet our running costs, which was also a condition of the Grant. I am always grateful for your regular generosity, and I hope that it will continue despite our dwindling numbers. On my behalf,
