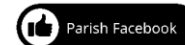

NUNCIO'S VISIT: During his visit to our Parish, we will hold ecumenical Vespers (Evening Prayer) at 5:30pm on the 23rd July at St. Mary's. Please invite as many people as possible. It is perhaps one of the most important events for the Parishes in years. Thank you for all your help and support. Bishop McGee wrote:

The Papal Nuncio, Archbishop Miguel Maury Buendía, is making a pastoral visit to every diocese in Scotland, England and Wales. He will be visiting Argyll and the Isles from Tuesday 22nd to Friday 25th July 2025. The Nuncio will visit each of our three deaneries, which will involve significant travel, but it will allow him to experience distinct flavours of our diocese.

As well as times of prayer and opportunities to meet with our parishioners the Nuncio desires to spend time with the clergy. Therefore, each day will finish with a meal to which all the priests and deacons of that deanery are invited. Gathering in deaneries will make travel easier for you but also create a more informal atmosphere for discussion. They may be opportunities for finding out more about Pope Leo XIV and perhaps some of his priorities.

Please see below the Nuncio's timetable. I ask that you please encourage your people to attend the Masses and other times of prayer. Parishioners and clergy may wish to participate not only in their deanery events but, if feasible, elsewhere too. The Nuncio is the Pope's personal representative in our country and welcoming him among us is a sign of our fidelity and affection for the Successor of Peter. It also provides an opportunity for us to pray together for Pope Leo as he begins his Petrine Ministry.

KILMORY GRAVEYARD: Tom Keenan has been working really hard to see the project going. There is a 'donation bucket' at the back of the church which serves for support of the project. It is entirely community run engagement which demonstrates great respect of our community toward its Christian heritage.
