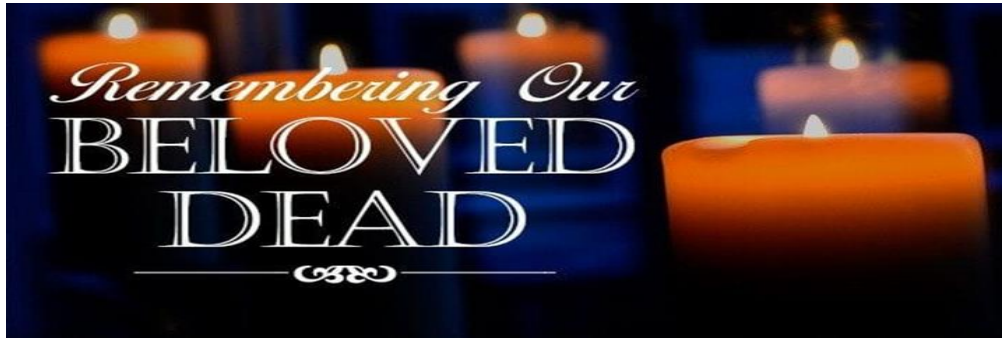

MORAR TOILET: We are currently waiting for the electrical works to be finished. I am sure Alistair Neil will be able to finalise it anytime.

EUCCHARISTIC MINISTERS: Last week I was a bit indisposed with a high risk of having to cancel Masses at short notice. During the last Clergy Assembly, we discussed what to do in such circumstances and it was suggested that if the Priest becomes unwell, is on a compassionate leave, and there is no possibility of cover, a Eucharistic Service might be offered instead. This will require special training for someone who would be able to lead the service. Each Church is to have such a designated Eucharistic Minister and if we are unable to find volunteers, it would mean no Eucharistic Service being offered in it. If this is something you would like to offer up for your Church Community, please speak to me as I would like volunteers coming willingly for this rather than approaching anyone individually. Training would involve around 2-3 sessions in the Chapel House.

PLASTERING AND REPAIRS TO ST. MARY'S: My sincere thanks to Paul May for his hard work in the Chapel House in Arisaig. He really worked hard and it took him a lot of time. Now what remains is for Duncan Macdonald to decorate it. After the storm, we also noticed a big leak coming from an area around the chimney into the ensuite bathroom. The panelling has been

stripped, and John would have to erect scaffolding to get access to the top and see what can be done. Until this happens, we are unable to let the house out and I hope and pray that it can be fixed before next booking at Christmas. Iain MacQueen will replace remaining handles. No sign of Ronnie Campbell... believe me I would like to see the scaffolding away and the insurance claim resolved as soon as possible. Many thanks for all the help.
